This manual explains how to install and use the **externallogin** package.

## 1. Installation

For the installation, you have to install the **externallogin** package. It contains:

- The main component
- A site login module
- An admin login module
- A system plugin (responsible for some specific actions)
- An authentication plugin (responsible for calling external login servers)

## 2. Configuration

You have to enable both plugins and to publish:

- a site login module (if you want to login on the public site using external login servers).
- an admin login module in the **login** position (if you want to login on the administrator site using external login servers).

You have to install some **External Login Plugins** such the CAS server plugin to be able to create external login servers. The parameters common to all external login servers are:

### **Title**

The server title. It must be unique.

### **Status**

The server status.

### **Auto-register**

Set true to auto-register new users.

### **Auto-update**

Set true to auto-update users.

### **Default user group**

The default user group users belong to.
